The 2009/2010 team will be looking to participate in tournaments in Michigan, Nevada, Colorado, Texas, Minnesota, California, and possibly north of the border - Canada. They will also participate in a minimum of six local tournaments and host up to two tournaments at Ice Den where teams from all over the United States travel to Arizona to participate in weekend tournaments for no charge.
